



## **VCS DRESS CODE 2019-2020**

K3 – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

The VCS Dress Code is designed to ensure our students dress in a way that is respectable, neat, and facilitates an atmosphere for learning. The goal is for students to make a daily decision to support the dress code in such a manner they are not purposely drawing undue or inappropriate attention to themselves. School administration has the final decision for student appearance for all school events and reserves the right to change any of the dress code at any time.

C & J Uniforms is the official supplier of the VCS plaid skirts and jumpers. For specific styles that are approved, please see the VCS website under the Parent link. Never hesitate to contact the school offices prior to purchasing questionable dress code items.

Students failing to comply with the dress code will be given escalated consequences based on the infraction and number of occurrences. Immodest and blatant infractions may result in removal from class until appropriate attire is acquired. Repeated violations will have consequences that include: loss of jeans day, loss of a particular dress code privilege, detention, or suspension.

### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- Attire should always be worn properly, clean, neat, without tears, and in good repair.
- During the school day, unapproved outerwear and blankets should remain in lockers until the end of the school day.
- Prints, patterns, decorations, and embellishments, as well as neon shades of any colors, are not allowed on tops or bottom clothing pieces. Solid only clothing is defined as one color on any one piece.
- Hair should be in a style, cut, and color that does not cause undue attention. Natural colors are approved. Boys' hair should not exceed the bottom of the collar, not be longer than the middle of the ear on the sides, and bangs cut above the eyebrows. No ponytails, mohawks, braiding, buns, or headbands are allowed for boys. Well-groomed mustaches are acceptable. No sideburns lower than the ear. Certain ethnic distinctions will be considered when in line with a student's heritage.
- Body piercing (except for girls' earrings) is not allowed; modest ear piercing for ladies should be no more than two piercings per ear. No head coverings of any type, including hats, visors, or hoods. No visible tattoos, no scarves, bandanas or distracting hair accessories.
- Undershirts or turtlenecks in solid white, navy, or black may be worn UNDER approved collared shirts.

## DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

All dress code clothing must fit properly and cover completely. Please make sure before leaving home that dress code items are approved and not too baggy or too tight. Please see VCS website for approved dress code styles before purchasing any dress code pieces.

### PANTS, SHORTS, SKIRTS, SKORTS & JUMPERS

- Colors: Solids in Black, Tan Khaki or Navy. Skirts, skorts, and jumpers in Black, Tan Khaki, Navy or VCS Plaid. The length of all shorts, jumpers or skirts must be no more than a dollar bill width above kneecap while standing. No jogging pants.

**Girls** may wear pants, capris, shorts (all without side or cargo pockets), or pleated skirts (may be worn with solid shorts, leggings, or tights). K-6th girls may also wear skorts (front skirt, back short), or jumpers.

**Boys** can wear pants or shorts without side or cargo pockets.

## SHIRTS, SWEATERS, and HOODIES

**Only the colors shown below will be accepted. If you have questions about a shirt color, please contact the school office prior to purchase.**

All tops must fit in way that when hands are lifted into the air, no skin shows at the waistline. Any brand **logo**, other than a VCS logo, must be smaller than palm-sized and on the upper chest area.

**Girls:** May wear polo's, button-down oxfords, and Peter-Pan rounded collars blouses.

**Boys:** May wear polo's and button-down oxfords.

- **Polo Colors:** Solids in White, Light Yellow, Red, Maroon, Light Pink, Light Blue, Royal Blue, Navy Blue, Gray, Black.
- **Button-Down Oxford Colors:** White, Light Yellow, Light Pink, Light Blue
- **Peter-Pan (rounded collars) Colors:** White, Light Yellow, Light Blue
- **Sweater & Hoodie Colors:** Solids in White, Light Yellow, Red, Maroon, Light Pink, Light Blue, Royal Blue, Navy Blue, Gray, Black.



A uniform style shirt must be worn under ALL sweatshirts, hoodies, zip pullovers, pullover sweaters, micro-fleece, and cardigan sweaters. Other outerwear should remain in locker during school hours. No other outerwear is allowed during school hours.

## VICTORY SPIRIT WEAR

VCS and Victory Church offer a variety of spirit wear through athletics, band, club and school sponsored sites, and the Victory Church Bookstore. Items purchased through these sites and stores with the Victory logo may be worn throughout the week, **if they are solid uniform approved colors.**

All other Spirit wear and Victory Church wear may be worn on Fridays with jeans.

## SHOES, BOOTS, SOCKS & LEGGINGS

Shoes must be neat and clean. Open toe or open back not allowed. No sandals, slippers, flip-flops, heels higher than 2 inches, roller shoes, or light-up shoes. Boots that are below the knee are acceptable. When wearing boots, pants may not be tucked into boots unless they are UGG style boots worn in the winter. Socks are not to be worn above the knee. Socks, leggings and tights that coordinate with the school uniform and do not draw undue attention are allowed.

## JEANS DAYS

Blue or black jeans, in good repair, may be worn with a VCS Spirit wear or athletic/band tops, polo shirt, or oxford button-down shirt in approved colors. Lower School students may wear jean shorts.
